Introduction

I first became interested in the number of mine fatalities in Butte while attending an institute entitled "Teaching Labor History" sponsored by the Teamsters= Union at Madison, Wisconsin in 1987. The attending teachers were given an assignment to prepare a classroom unit on some aspect of labor history from their local areas. Brian Shovers had just published an article in the Spring edition of the *Montana Magazine of Western History*, and I used this as a basis of my teaching unit and my further investigations.

As a youth growing up in Butte's mining district during the 1940s and 1950s, my memories of the danger of working in Butte mines consisted of the almost natural order of daily mine alarms indicating an accident, injured miners sitting on benches waiting for treatment in hospital emergency rooms, the miners= wards at St. James and Murray Hospitals, and a notable lack of fathers in homes on the hill. My curiosity aroused, I began to compile lists of those who had been killed. I was appalled by my findings.

Mining was a highly skilled and dangerous occupation. During the early years of extracting and milling ore from the regional mines, experienced men from Wales, Cornwall, Ireland, and the Comstock and other Western mining districts provided the labor and skills necessary to extract the ore in a reasonably safe manner. The original miners from mining districts in Cornwall and Ireland - Teaching members of your nationality - Once new miners from agricultural regions deaths multiplied. One of the constant demands of the miner training classes - Your life depended upon it.

² Coroners Inquest testimony place the deaths in the Anaconda Mine on Nov, 23 1889 and was printed in a newspaper on June 15, 1890. The bodies recovered of Jerry Sullivan, Harry Page and Edward Dolan were taken from the Anaconda mine on 6/18/90. RESEARCH NOTES - THE GRANITE MOUNTAIN-SPECULATOR FIRE FATALITIES

by James D. Harrington (Last Revision: December 9, 1997)

A major problem exists with the identification of those who died at the Granite Mountain-Speculator disaster - the worst hard rock mining accident in the nation's history. The large numbers that were killed, the rapid decomposition of the bodies, the great numbers of rescue workers coming from other mines, etc. all tend to make an accurate listing impossible.

Each source examined disagrees with other sources in numbers, names, and spellings. Newspaper articles describing the burial of several of those killed introduce new names to be considered. A few individuals were listed by nicknames and again by first names, and others by both their natural surnames and the Americanization of them. Death certificates, mortuary records, newspaper articles and obituaries, coroner records, the Industrial Accident reports, as well as the monument to the unidentified Granite Mountain dead at the Mountain View Cemetery, were all used.

Although 163 fatalities is the figure given in most historical reports, the Silver Bow County Coroner's Report claims a total of 162 dead in the Speculator, with two others, Con O'Neill and Ed Lorey, losing their lives on June 9 in the nearby Bell Mine from "Asphyxiation from gas & smoke in mine fire accidental," the same language used for the Speculator victims. It appears that at least 167 individuals lost their lives in the disaster, perhaps more. The names of a few additional individuals, who are listed by only one or two sources and whose identifications are questionable, are provided at the end.
