After I turned the tape off, Pete was much more talkative and relaxed. He talked about some of his high school career at Butte High. He moved to Butte with his brother when he was fifteen and considered himself a man. He didn't think he needed to go to school. He got a job at his uncle's electrical business and in a few years was making \$200 more per month than students who had just received degrees in electrical engineering. Why go to school when you're making that money? He decided to go anyway and was allowed to take five solid courses. The sixth one had to be either football or gym class. He chose football.
